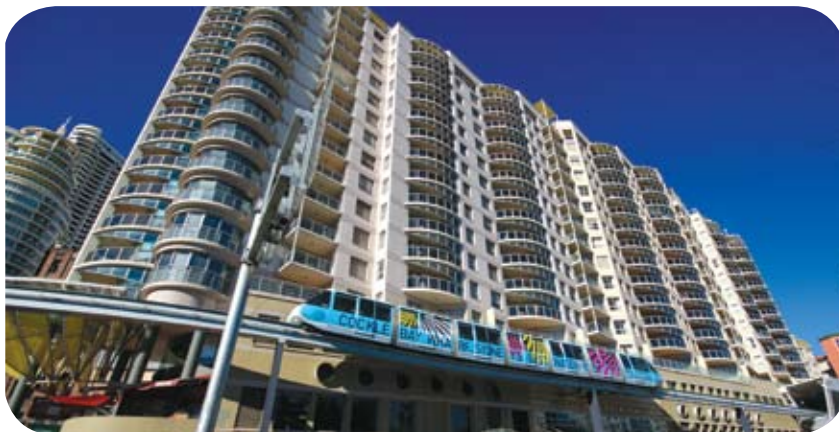


Harbour Garden Towers Darling Harbour, Harbour Street

Darling Harbour, a locality of Sydney is a large recreational, pedestrian precinct. It is situated at Sydney central business district. The predominant age group in Darling Harbour (Haymarket) is 20 - 29 years. The locality extends northwards from Chinatown, along both sides of Cockle Bay to King Street Wharf on the east, and to the suburb of Pyrmont on the west. Cockle Bay is just one of the waterways that make up Darling Harbour, which opens north into the much larger Port Jackson.
